



Checklist – Artistic Master Class



We are very pleased that you are interested in studying in the Artistic Master Class at the Palucca University of Dance Dresden. Specific requirements must be met to study in Artistic Master Class. Our checklist serves as a guide for you.

After passing the exam, the Artistic Master Class is completed with a **certificate**; no Master of Arts degree is achieved.

The Artistic Master Class is the right course for you if:

- as a dancer, choreographer or dance teacher, you have already completed or will soon complete a dance-related **university degree** (80% of the examinations for the degree must have already been successfully completed - proof required)
- you can work **independently and self-responsibly**
- an artistic member of staff from **Palucca University of Dance Dresden** is willing to be your **mentor***
- you already have **basic knowledge of research methods and approaches**
- you are pursuing a **research topic with the respective research thesis** and want to work on it
- you can explain why the Palucca University of Dance Dresden is the right place for your further artistic qualification

To apply, you will need to submit the following documents:

- a letter of motivation (1 A4 page) outlining your reasons for your application for the Artistic Masterclass and the goals you aim to achieve with the course
- an exposé (max. 6 A4 pages) on your artistic-theoretical project idea or on the topic of artistic research and the planned implementation at the Palucca University of Dance Dresden with suggestions for the course of study, possible examinations and with the written confirmation of supervision from the mentor, and including the following:
 - **research topic**
 - **preliminary work on the research topic**
 - **goals**
 - **results / target group**
 - **structure and schedule**
 - **name of the mentor and their written consent of supervision**
- overview of your education background
- proof of passed exams and degrees
- documentation of artistic and creative achievements
- 1 passport / portrait photo
